ACADEMIC HONORS

Academic Honors are applied only at the undergraduate level and are denoted on each semester as Honors (3.5 - 3.74 GPA), High Honors (3.75- 3.99) or Highest Honors (4.00).

ACADEMIC STANDING

Students are considered in good academic standing with a 2.0 Boise State GPA. Students are placed on Probation if one of the two conditions exist: 0 - 25 cumulative credits earned with a Boise State Cumulative GPA of 1.75 or below OR 26 or more cumulative credits earned with a Boise State Cumulative GPA below 2.0. Continued Probation is applied to students who achieve a 2.0 semester GPA, but whose cumulative has not reached minimum. Students are dismissed if the Cumulative Boise State GPA is below the minimum specified (1.75 or 2.0) AND the semester GPA is below a 2.0. Academic Dismissal is not based on student conduct.

GRADE EXCLUSION

Boise State allows students to exclude up to 2 semesters of grades if the student has not been enrolled for five years or eight years have elapsed since the grades were received. Grade Exclusion is denoted on the transcript by "Grade Exclusion Approved" on the term.

REPEAT OF A COURSE

If a course is repeated, both grades appear on the transcript, but only the most recent grade is used in GPA calculation. Exception: grades for courses taken and repeated beginning Fall 1995 through Summer 2001 appear on the transcript, and both grades are averaged in GPA calculations.

COURSE NUMBER ADDITIONS

"C" = Correspondence Courses
"G" = Graduate-level Courses (may be used for 300 and up)
"H" = Honors Courses




